Psalm 119:121-128

Psalm 119 is the longest Psalm, is poetry, is an acrostic of the Hebrew alphabet, and has many synonyms for the Word of God, most of which are used in each section of the Psalm.

KJV Psalm 119:105 Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

- "word" (דְּבְר) *davar* Any word that proceeds from the mouth of the Lord – including the Scripture.
- ESV 121 I have done what is just and <u>right;</u> do not leave me to my oppressors.
- "right" (מִשְׁפָּט) *mishpat* Judgment (authoritative legal decision) given by the supreme judge, God Himself.
- ¹²² Give your servant a pledge of good; let not the insolent oppress me.
- ¹²³ My eyes long for your salvation and for the fulfillment of your righteous promise.
- "promise" (אָמְרָה) *imrah* "utterance, speech, word" God said it. His word is His bond.
- ¹²⁴ Deal with your servant according to your steadfast love, and teach me your <u>statutes</u>.

"statutes" – (חֹק) *hoque* – This word has the sense of a boundary or limit. God's statutes give the proper limits of our behavior.

¹²⁵ I am your servant; give me understanding, that I may know your <u>testimonies</u>!

"testimonies" – (עֵדוּת) eidot - This word comes from the

word for "witness" or "testify." It occurs in the phrases "the two tablets of the Testimony" (Exodus 31:18) and "the ark of the Testimony" (Exodus 25:22).

¹²⁶ It is time for the LORD to act, for your <u>law</u> has been broken.

"law" – (תּוֹרָה) torah –

<u>Narrow meaning</u>: Torah of Moses, Pentateuch. <u>Broad meaning</u>: Any instruction flowing from the revelation of God as the basis for life and action.

¹²⁷ Therefore I love your <u>commandments</u> above gold, above fine gold.

"commandments" – (מִצְוָה) *mitzvah* - Anything that the Lord has ordered.

¹²⁸ Therefore I consider all your <u>precepts</u> to be right; I hate every false way.

"precepts" – (פָּקוּדִים) *piqqudim* – Instructions, directions, orders

In every aspect this is a carefully and beautifully written Psalm.

Do you appreciate this Psalm? Do you value this Psalm? Do you believe this Psalm? Is this Psalm for us from God Himself?

But there is a problem. Illustration:

Here are two passages that have had a huge impact on me... Joshua 1:8 and Psalm 1. Both of these speak of a very personal commitment to follow what God says.

This is why we need to have <u>daily</u> personal <u>devotions</u>. This is why church is important. This is why fellowship is important.
